Code of Ethics

Halifax Kennel Club

- 1. Members shall undertake to educate the public in all aspects of their breed(s). They also shall educate the public in any way that will benefit purebred dogs
- 2. Members shall undertake to maintain their dogs in accordance with the regulations (Schedule A) of the Animal Protection Act of Nova Scotia.
- 3. It is the objective of the Halifax Kennel Club to promote and encourage the welfare of the purebred dog.
- 4. The Halifax Kennel Club wishes to encourage sportsmanship, fellowship and goodwill among its members in all club activities.
- 5. The Halifax Kennel Club considers it unethical for any of its members to sell dogs to pet stores, wholesalers or brokers dealing in dogs, or to knowingly sell to any person who sells to pet stores, wholesalers or brokers. They should not knowingly allow any of their dogs to be used in raffles, lotteries, auctions or as competition prizes.
- 6. Members of the Halifax Kennel Club shall refrain from making unjustified derogatory comments, direct or implied, about the Club, an official of the Club, another member or their dogs.
- 7. No membership will be considered valid until this Code of Ethics is signed and on file.
- 8. Each new member shall be provided with the Constitution and By-Laws of the Halifax Kennel Club.
